Mr. V. Lalnunnema s/o Dingluaia is a resident of Bungtlang village, who is the chairman of Fine Rice WRC/TRC FIG. He cultivates paddy in his 2 ha of land located at Lungzawl zau. His paddy field is the main source of income. Due to shortage of income he wants to increase his production area by joining of small plots into bigger plots. Upon hearing his problem DMU Serchhip have allotted one unit under Support for wetland agriculture.

After FOCUS intervention, his rice production increases from 24 quintal to 30 quintal (in paddy) with an income from Rs.25,000 to 45000. He not only sell his produces to the market but also for his family consumption. And from mustard he also earned more from Rs.10000 to Rs.16000. They are very grateful to FOCUS Project.
