SUCCESS STORY OF FARMER FOR CONSTRUCTION OF GABION BOX FOR STREAM BANK EROSION CONTROL

Pu Lalhmunsanga s/o C. Lalbela is from Serchhip who registered himself as member of Ramlai 2 WRC/TRC FIG under DMU-FOCUS Serchhip on 2019. He is rice farmer having paddy field from the year 1960 which is located at zawlpui zau. He also grows rapeseed mustard, rabi crops other than rice.

The main problem and constraints is that lumtui river flows at the side of his paddy field and this floods caused landslip of his paddy field bunds. Due to this he could not cultivate rice for many years during monsoon. To deal with his problems DMU-FOCUS had allotted 1 unit for construction of gabion box under Stream bank erosion control during 2022. After construction of gabion box his problem was solved and able to cultivate again. He increased his cultivation area and started growing paddy, rapeseed mustard, green peas and brinjal. From this, his rice production increased from 3 quintal to 18 quintal (in paddy). And also earned more from various crops. He is very grateful and found it profitable that he got registered in FOCUS FIG.
