INTRODCUTION: Village Council of E. Lungdar village allotted land at tuipui zau for Tuipui landless FIG member. At present, 20 families cultivated kharif and rabi crops. Their land is located near Tuipui river and have a good source of water. But during dry season, there is shortage of water for irrigating their crops due to lack of water storage structure.

FOCUS INTERVENTION: DMU-Serchhip FOCUS alloted 1 no. of water harvesting structure in which FIG members contributed money and constructed two (2) water intake. After completion, the stored water is collected by using power pump (water pump) which they have received from FOCUS. Thus, increases the availability of water during dry season and fully utilized for rabi cultivation and their income is also increased, FIG members are grateful to FOCUS project.
