1. The Government of Mizoram through Society for Climate Resilient Agriculture in Mizoram (SCRAM) has received financing from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) towards the cost of Fostering Climate Resilient Upland Farming System in the Northeast (FOCUS), Mizoram, and intends to apply part of the financing for the recruitment of consulting services. The use of any IFAD financing shall be subject to IFAD's approval, pursuant to the terms and conditions of the financing agreement, as well as IFAD's rules, policies and procedures. IFAD and its officials, agents and employees shall be held harmless from and against all suits, proceedings, claims, demands, losses and liability of any kind or nature brought by any party in connection with Fostering Climate Resilient Upland Farming System in the Northeast (FOCUS), Mizoram
2. The client now invites proposals to provide the following consulting services for **“Impact Studies on Boar Semen Station) under FOCUS-Mizoram project”**. For this assignment, Kolasib and Mamit Districts have been purposely selected for this study since Kolsaib district has been considered as the fore runner in implementing this activity and Mamit has the largest village covered among the FOCUS districts
3. This Request for Expression of Interest (REOI) is open for response by any interested and qualified bidders/firms which should be selected based on Consultant Qualification Selection (CQS) method. The Service Provider expressing interest for the assignment should have the following minimum eligibility conditions.
  - i. Any legal entity/institution registered in India under relevant Act (University/Society/Company/Trust/Cooperative/NGOs)
  - ii. Minimum 3 years' of working experience in the field of Veterinary Extension within the state.
  - iii. Should have undertaken at least 2 studies on similar or relevant assignment/objectives in the field of Veterinary Extension.
  - iv. Should have operating office with manpower in Aizawl, Mizoram.

4. Before preparing its EOIs, the consultant is advised to review the preliminary terms of reference attached as Annex 1, which describe the assignment and Annex 2 that details the evaluation of the technical qualifications.
5. The consultant shall not have any actual, potential or reasonably perceived conflict of interest. A consultant with an actual, potential or reasonably perceived conflict of interest shall be disqualified unless otherwise explicitly approved by the Fund. A consultant including their respective personnel and affiliates are considered to have a conflict of interest if they a) have a relationship that provides them with undue or undisclosed information about or influence over the selection process and the execution of the contract, b) participate in more than one EOI under this procurement action, c) have a business or family relationship with a member of the client's board of directors or its personnel, the Fund or its personnel, or any other individual that was, has been or might reasonably be directly or indirectly involved in any part of (i) the preparation of this expression of interest, (ii) the selection process for this procurement, or (iii) execution of the contract. The consultant has an ongoing obligation to disclose any situation of actual, potential or reasonably perceived conflict of interest during preparation of the EOI, the selection process or the contract execution. # ANNEX 1

## **Preliminary Terms of Reference (ToR) for conducting Impact Studies on Boar Semen Station under FOCUS Project**

**Project: Fostering Climate Resilient Upland Farming Systems in the Northeast-Mizoram (FOCUS-Mizoram), Government of Mizoram, funded by the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD)**

### **1. CLIENT**

The client for this assignment is Society for Climate Resilient Agriculture in Mizoram (SCRAM). SCRAM is a registered society under Department of Agriculture, Government of Mizoram.

### **2. BACKGROUND OF THE PROJECT**

The Fostering Climate Resilient Upland Farming System in the Northeast (FOCUS), Mizoram was started on January, 2018 as a society under Department of Agriculture- Society for Climate Resilient Agriculture in Mizoram (SCRAM). The project is divided into three (3) components which is to be completed within 2024.

The Project components emphasis to increase the agricultural income of those targeted households in the project districts and to enhance their resilience to climate change. The FOCUS project has three components, namely,

- a) Improved Agricultural Resilience and Productivity;
- b) Value Chain and Market Access; and
- c) Project Management and Knowledge services

### **3. RATIONALE OF THE ASSIGNMENT**

FOCUS Project recognized that Artificial Insemination is the key in pig reproduction and any effort to develop this activity will go in a long way in the breeding activities both in the rural and urban areas as well as up to village level. Boar Semen Stations were constructed in four (4) districts viz. Kolasib, Serchhip, Mamit and Champhai district. Civil construction of all the buildings and biosecurity were completed by Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Department in convergence with National Livestock Mission (NLM) which account for 61.70% of the total project cost. Material equipments,

propulsion cost, technical and non-technical staff salary were contributed by FOCUS which account for 38.30% of the total cost.

The situational analysis and before and after the intervention of the Project in regards to the Boar Semen Station is not systematically captured and no such measurement has been undertaken to analyze the impact. However monthly report on number of pigs inseminated with the Artificial Insemination Success Rate (%) has been recorded. The consultant may prepare a baseline indicating the level of improvement before the project intervention and including traditional practices of natural insemination by the farmers and comparing the AI success rate, litter size of the sow, cost effectiveness etc in order to provide a significant outcome for the study. Consultant's proposed methodology will be an important factor.

#### **4. OBJECTIVES**

- 4.1 To study the socio-economic, personal and psychological impact on the farmers
- 4.2 To study the success rate of conception (%).
- 4.3 To study the growth rate and weaning age of the piglets

#### **5. SCOPE OF THE ASSIGNMENT**

The scope of the assignment is to -

- (i) Conduct an assessment for an in-depth understanding of before and after the introduction of Artificial Insemination in pigs in the selected villages.
- (ii) The present study shall make an attempt to examine the production and marketing potential of the farmers which will ensure the nutritional and livelihood security, increase farm productivity, income and sustainability of the farmers.
- (iii) The findings of the study is expected to help in formulating strategies and policy guidelines by promoting entrepreneurial ventures and minimize the constraints faced by the farmers
- (iv) Organize meetings/workshops to present the findings of the assessments to the staffs of the DMU, relevant line department officials and key stakeholders and
- (v) Draw a roadmap for disseminating actionable adaptation and up-scaling and replicating the successful models in all the project villages and in the state with similar agro-ecological condition.

#### **6. METHODOLOGY**

##### **6.1. Selection of the district**

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Out of the six districts under FOCUS project, Kolasib and Mamit Districts have been purposely selected for this study since Kolsaib district has been considered as the fore runner in implementing this activity and Mamit has the largest village covered among the FOCUS districts.

## **6.2 Selection of the village**

A total of 300 farmers will be selected for the study from two districts. The collection of the sample should follow a methodology which is recognized in the academia and supported by research papers published in the high impact journals.

The study should follow a methodology which is recognized in the academia and supported by research papers published in the high impact journals. The impact study should be compatible to the highest resolution soil water regime models.

1. The socio-economic, personal and psychological characteristics of the farmers.
2. The rate of adoption of Artificial Insemination by the farmers consisting of the following parameters-
  - ✓ Number of AI done in sows
  - ✓ Number of farmers
  - ✓ Conception rate
  - ✓ AI Success Rate
  - ✓ Number of piglets born
  - ✓ Weaning age of the piglets
3. The entrepreneurial behaviour of the selected respondents and the factors influencing it.
4. The constraints faced by the farmers in terms of detecting the heat of the sows, time of farrowing and taking care of new born piglets.
